STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2: This clause amends section 66B of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance (Chapter 262) by the repeal of subsection (4) of that section and it is consequential to the amendments made to Municipal Council Ordinance (Chapter 252), Urban Councils Ordinance (Chapter 255) and Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987, and the legal effect due to such repeal will be to revert back to the procedure followed by the Municipal Council, Urban Council or Pradeshiya Sabha, prior to the Local Authorities Elections (Amendment) Act, No. 22 of 2012 when re-submitting a budget or supplementary budget to the Municipal Council, Urban Council or Pradeshiys Sabha, as the case may be.

An ACT TO AMEND THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 262)

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities Short title Elections (Amendment) Act, No. of 2014 and shall come and date of 5 into operation on such date as the Minister may appoint by operation. Order published in the Gazette.

2. Section 66B of the Local Authorities Elections Amendment Ordinance (Chapter 262) as last amended by Act, No. 22 of of section 2012 is hereby further amended as follows:—

66B of the Local Authorities

- 10 (1) in subsection (2) of that section by the substitution Elections for the words "shall, subject to the provisions of Ordinance subsection (4) of this section, call upon the Secretary" of the words "shall, call upon the Secretary";
- 15 (2) by the repeal of subsection (4) of that section.
 - In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala text Sinhala and Tamil texts of this Act, Sinhala text shall prevail. to prevail in

case of inconsistency.
