AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE NADUATHUL ULAMA ARABIC COLLEGE, MUTUR

WHEREAS an College called and known as the Preamble. "Naduathul Ulama Arabic College" has been formed at Mutur, Sri Lanka for the purpose of effectually fulfilling and carrying out all the objects and matters connected with

- 5 the said "Naduathul Ulama Arabic College" according to the rules agreed to by its members and whereas the said institution has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted the several objects and matters for which it was established:
- 10 AND the Board of Management of the said "Mutur Naduathul Ulama Arabic College" has applied to incorporate the college and it will be for the public advantage to grant such application:

BE it therefore enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic 15 Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Naduathul Ulama Arabic Short title. College, Mutur (Incorporation) Act, No. 2016.

2. From and after the date of commencement of this Act, Incorporation the persons who had heretofore managed and carried on the of the

- 20 affairs of the Mutur Naduathul Ulama Arabic College Ulama Arabic (hereinafter referred to as the "College") and the persons who College, shall hereafter be admitted to the Board of Management in Mutur. accordance with the provisions of this Act and rules made thereunder, shall be and become an incorporated body
- 25 (hereinafter referred to as the" Corporation") with the perpetual succession under the name and the style of "Mutur Naduathul Ulama Arabic College" and by that name may sue and be sued in all courts ,with full power and authority to have and use a common seal and alter the same at its will and pleasure.

3. The general objects for which the Corporation is General objects of the corporation.

- (*a*) to improve the religious, educational, social, economical and cultural development of Muslims in Sri Lanka;
- (b) to encourge the teaching of Arabic Language, its grammar, literature, verse and prose and poems, and other similar subects to enable the students to gain the complete knowledge, skills and abilities in Arabic Language;
- (c) to improve the teaching of 'Sharia' or Islamic Law in accordance with 'Fiqh' 'Tafseer' and 'Hadeeths' and other similar subjects which are available in Arabic language;
- 15 (d) to encourage the teaching of recital of 'Al Quran' according to 'Thajweed' and 'Hifdhul Quran', the recital from memory of the 'Holy Quran';
 - (e) to encourage the teaching of other subjects similar to these, which are available in Arabic Language and are helpful to the students to gain an intense knowledge in matters mentioned in paragraph (a), (b), (c) and (d); and
 - (f) to do all the acts and things which are necessary or conducive to the attainment of the above mentioned objects or any one of them since they are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any other written law :

Provided always that the subjects referred to in this section shall be exclusively in accordance with the "Sunnath 30 Waljamaath".

4. Subject to the provisions of this Act and any other General written law the Corporation shall have the power to do, perform and execute all such acts, matters and things whatsoever as are necessary, desirable or expendient for the

- 5 promotion or furtherance of the objects of the Corporation or any one of them including the power to open, operate and close bank accounts, to borrow or raise money with or without security, to invest its funds, to engage, employ and dismiss officers and servants for the carrying out of the objects of the
- 10 Corporation.

5. (1) The affairs of the Corporation shall, subject to the Management rules of the Corporation be administered by a Board of of the affairs of the Management consisting of members elected in accordance Corporation. with the rules of the Corporation.

- 15 (2) The first Board of Management of the Corporation shall be the members of the Board of Management of College holding office on the day preceding the date of commencement of this Act.
- 6. (1) It shall be lawful for the Corporation from time Rules of the 20 to time at any General Meeting of the Members and by the votes of not less than two-thirds of the members present and voting to make rules which are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any other written law for the management of the affairs of the Corporation and
- 25 accomplishment of its objects, such rules when made may at the meeting and in like manner be altered, added to, amended or rescinded.

(2) The rules of the College in force on the preceding date of the commencement of this Act, shall be deemed to be 30 the rules of the Corporation made under this section.

(3) The members of the Corporation shall be subject to the rules of the Corporation.

8. The Corporation shall be able in law to take and hold Corporation any property movable or immovable which may become may hold and vested it by virtue of any purchase, grant, gift, testamentary dispose of property disposition or otherwise and all such property shall be held movable and

9. The money and property of the Corporation Fund of the whensoever deriving shall be applied solely towards the Corporation. 15 promotion of its objects as set forth herein, and no portion

thereof shall be paid or transfrerred directly or indirectly by way of divident, loan, or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to the members of the Corporation :

Provided however, that the provisions of this section 20 shall not prohibit-

- (a) the payment in good faith of reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or employee of the Corporation for any service rendered by him to the Corporation;
- 25 (b) the payment of reasonable and proper rent for premises let to the Corporation by any member of the Corporation or by any company of which a member of the Corporation is a shareholder; and
 - (c) the reimbursment or repayment of reasonable and proper expenses incurred with the prior approval of the Board of Management by any member, officer or employee of the Corporation in the discharge or performance of his function or duties or in promotion of the objects of the Corporation.
