#### Holidays (Amendment)

#### An Act to amend the Holidays Act, No. 29 of 1971

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Holidays (Amendment) Short title. Act, No. of 2019.
- 2. The following new section is hereby inserted Insertion of immediately after section 14 of the Holidays Act, No. 29 of new section 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal enactment") and shall have effect as section 14A of that enactment:—

14<sub>A</sub> to the Holidays Act, No. 29 of 1971.

- "14A. No person shall on any Full Moon 10 Poya Day or any Sunday till 3.00 p.m. conduct or caused to be conducted or facilitate for any tuition class for students attending schools at any premises or any location.".
- 3. Section 17 of this Act is hereby amended by deleting Amendment 15 the words "One thousand rupees" and by substitution therefor of the following words "Ten thousand rupees".
