#### STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2: This clause amends section 88 of the Civil Procedure Code (Chapter 101) and the legal effect of the section as amended is to provide for an appeal to the Provincial High Court with leave obtained first in case of an order setting aside or refusing to set aside the judgment entered upon default.

L.D.-O. 29/2021

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CIVIL PROCEDURE CODE (CHAPTER 101)

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Civil Procedure Code Short title (Amendment) Act, No. of 2021.

- 5 2. Section 88 of the Civil Procedure Code (Chapter 101) Amendment is hereby amended by the repeal of subsection (2) of that  $\begin{array}{c} \text{of section 88} \\ \text{of Chapter} \\ 101 \end{array}$ therefor:-
- "(2) The order setting aside or refusing to set aside the judgment entered upon default shall accompany 10 the facts upon which it is adjudicated and specify the grounds upon which it is made, and shall be liable to an appeal to the relevant High Court established by Article 154P of the Constitution, with leave first had 15 and obtained from such High Court.".
