STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2: This clause amends section 3 of the Fiscal Management (Responsibility) Act, No. 3 of 2003 by amending paragraphs (e) and (f) thereof and the legal effect of this section as amended is to revise the objectives underlying responsible fiscal management–

- (a) by increasing the guarantee limit specified in paragraph (e) up to 15 percent; and
- (b) by moving the established debt to gross domestic product target, to year 2030.
