STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

 ${\it Clause}\ 2$: This clause amends section 5 of the Carriage by Air Act and the legal effect of the section as amended is to provide for the Minister to specify the limits of liability for domestic carriage by air, whereby the higher threshold applicable to the limits of liability for international carriage by air will not be applicable to domestic carriage by air.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CARRIAGE BY AIR ACT, No. 29 of 2018

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Carriage by Air Short title (Amendment) Act, No. of 2023.
- 2. Section 5 of the Carriage by Air Act, No. 29 of 2018 Amendment of is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after Act, No. 29 of subsection (2) of that section, of the following new 2018 subsections:-

- "(3) The Minister may, from time to time by Order 10 published in the Gazette, specify the limits of liability as may be applicable to carriage by air not being international carriage by air.".
