Parliamentary Elections (Amendment)

AN ACT TO AMEND THE PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT, NO. 1 OF 1981

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as Parliamentary Elections Short title (Amendment) Act, No. of 2024.

- 5 Section 7 of the Parliamentary Elections Act, Amendment 2. No. 1 of 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal of Section 7 enactment" as amended by Act, No. 58 of 2009, is hereby Parliamentary further amended by the repeal of subsection 4(d) and Elections Act, substitution thereof, with the following:-No. 1 of 1981
- "(d) In order to guarantee better representation of 10 women in political parties and in politics, every recognized political party shall ensure the inclusion of not less than thirty per centum of women office bearers, in a decision making 15 capacity, in the list of office bearers of such party.".

3. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala Sinhala text to prevail in and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall prevail. case of
