**THE PREVENTION OF TERRORISM (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
ACT, No 48 OF 1970**

**REGULATIONS** made by the Minister under section 27 of the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act, No. 48 of 1979 read with paragraph (2) of Article 44 of the Constitution.

**Regulations**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Extension of Application) Regulations No. 3 of 2011.

2. The application of the provisions of the regulations specified in Column I of the Schedule to these regulations shall, in furtherance of the efforts of the Government of Sri Lanka made in good faith for the purpose of ensuring the continuance of peace within the country, be deemed to continue to be in force till the dates specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of the Schedule hereto, notwithstanding the fact that the state of emergency declared by Proclamation in terms of section 2 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40) has lapsed and any regulation made under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance (Chapter 40) has with effect from August 30, 2011 ceased to be valid and effectual.
