**Regulations Under Section 101 (Chapter 235) of The Customs Ordinance**

DETERMINATION OF COST OF TRANSPORT FOR CUSTOMS VALUATION, WHEN THE  
IMPORTER IMPORTS HIS OWN GOODS BY HIS OWN VESSEL

1. BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 101 (1) (h) of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 235), I, Mahinda Rajapaksa, Minister of Finance and Planning, being satisfied that it is necessary and expedient so to do, hereby fix, when the importer's own ship is used for importing of their own goods to any port in Sri Lanka, the cost of such transport for the purpose of customs valuation referred to in Article 8.1(e)(i) of Schedule E to the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 235), as fifteen per cent of the Free On Board (FOB) value of such goods.

2. These regulations may be cited as Customs Valuation Regulation No. 01 of 2012 and shall come into operation on 04, May 2012.
