FILLING OF A VACANCY IN THE MEMBER OF THE WILGAMUWA PRADESHIYA SABHA UNDER SECTION 65A(2) OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 262) AS AMENDED BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ACT, NO. 30 OF 2013

WHEREAS the office of a member in Wilgamuwa Pradeshiya Sabha has fallen vacant by reason of Death;

And whereas the Secretary of the recognized political party namely United People's Freedom Alliance, to which the member Yapa Mudiyanseelage Sooriya Bandara belonged, was required by me under Section 65A(2) of the aforesaid Ordinance, to nominate within a period of thirty (30) days a person eligible under the Ordinance for election as a member of that Wilgamuwa Pradeshiya Sabha who shall be declared elected as a member;

And whereas the Secretary of the aforesaid recognised political party has failed to make a nomination within the period specified;

Now therefore, I, Sudu Dewage Shanika Anuruddha Rupasinghe, Returning Officer of Wilgamuwa Pradeshiya Sabha, acting in terms of Section 65A(2) of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance as amended by filling of vacancies in Local Authorities (Special Provisions) Act, No. 30 of 2013 (Chapter 262) do hereby declare Mr. M. M. A. G. Rupasinghe Bandara who had secured the highest number of preferences next to the last of the member declared elected at the election held on 23rd July 2011 to Wilgamuwa Pradeshiya Sabha elected as a Member of the Wilgamuwa Pradeshiya Sabha in respect of which such vacancy occurred.
