**FILLING OF A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF DEPUTY MAYOR OF THE
NEGOMBO MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
UNDER SECTION 65A(1) OF THE
LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE
(CHAPTER 262) AS AMENDED BY
LOCAL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ACT, No. 30 OF 2013**

WHEREAS the office of Deputy Mayor in Negombo Municipal Council has fallen vacant by reason of being elected as a member of the Western Province Provincial Council ;

AND WHEREAS the Secretary of the United People's Freedom Alliance, the recognized political party to which M. S. M. Sakawulla of the former Deputy Mayor belonged, was required by me under Section 65A(1) of the aforesaid Ordinance, to decide upon the member of that Negombo Municipal Council who belongs to such party who shall be declared elected as Deputy Mayor within a period of thirty (30) days ;

AND WHEREAS the Secretary of the aforesaid recognized political party has communicated his decision to nominate Mr. Dayan Lansa Moses Warnakulasooriya to fill such vacancy ;

NOW THEREFORE I, Pathiraja Arachchillage Sunil Senarathna, Returning Officer of Negombo Municipal Council acting in terms of Section 65A(1) of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance as amended by filling of vacancies in Local Authorities (Special Provisions) Act, No. 30 of 2013 (Chapter 262) do hereby declare Mr. Dayan Lansa Moses Warnakulasooriya elected as Deputy Mayor of the Negombo Municipal Council.
