SCHEDULE

The decisions made by the wages board for the Beedi Manufacturing Trade set out in the Schedule to notification published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No.11208, of November 29, 1957, as varied from time to time and last varied by the notification published in *Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 1789/19, of 12th December 2012, shall be further varied by the substitution for part II of that schedule, of the following new part.

PART II

The minimum rates of the wages for piece work for Beedi Rolling (Inclusive of the preparation of wrappers for rolling, cutting wrapping, leaves, filling wrappers with “Beedi Tobacco”, Beedi Rolling and Tying rolled Beedies) shall be:

(a) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long	Rs. 400.00
(b) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long but less than 3 inches	Rs. 450.00
(c) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long	Rs. 490.00

The minimum rates of wages for piece work for Beedi Rolling (Inclusive of filling wrappers with “Beedi Tobacco” Beedi Rolling and tying rolled Beedies but exclusive of the preparation of wrappers for rolling and cutting wrapping, leaves) shall be:

(a) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long	Rs. 300.00
(b) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long but less than 3 inches	Rs. 340.00
(c) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long	Rs. 375.00

The minimum rates of wages for piece work for cutting, wrapping, leaves (inclusive of the preparation of wrappers for rolling) shall be:

(a) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long	Rs. 200.00
(b) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long but less than 3 inches	Rs. 220.00
(c) For 1000 beedies not more than 2 inches long	Rs. 230.00

The minimum rates of the wages for piece work for fixing ring labels round rolled Beedies shall be Rs. 50.00 per 1000 Beedies.

Whenever a worker is employed to tap toddy for the Arrack Trade or Vinegar Trade, the aforesaid rate should be paid to him for tapping Coconut, Kithul a Palmyrah palms subject to the condition that the alcohol content of the volume of toddy delivered by him should be not less than 7.5%. However if the alcohol content of the volume of toddy is less than 7.5% he should be paid in proportion to the aforesaid rate.

PART III

Minimum rate of wages for time work applicable to the workers specified in column I, shall be the corresponding rates set out in column II.

In any month where the period of unauthorized absence of a worker exceeds 4 days he shall be paid as wages for that month the balance wage after deducting the proportionate amount of the monthly salary for the number of days exceeding the authorized 4 days leave.
