EXCISE (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ACT, No. 13 OF 1989

Order under Section 3

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 3 of the Excise (Special Provisions) Act, No. 13 of 1989, as amended, I, Mangala Samaraweera, Minister of Finance, do by this Order declare that, the Excise Duty charged, levied and collected on motor vehicles imported during the period of January 2015 to November 2017 specified in Column I of the Schedule I hereto shall be payable at the rate specified in Column II of the Schedule I wherever applicable with effect from April 05, 2019.

Any importer/individual who is fulfilling the criteria specified in the Schedule I to this Order and willing to release his/her motor vehicles, on payment of such special duty rate should submit his/her application as specified in the Schedule II to this Order to the Director General, Department of Fiscal Policy of the General Treasury on or before August 05, 2019.

SCHEDULE I

<i>Description</i> <i>I</i>	<i>Excise Duty</i> <i>II</i>
1. Motor vehicles, which were imported during the period of January 2015 to November 2017 and pending for Customs clearance at the Port of Sri Lanka (Hambantota) shall be released to the importer(s) subject to fulfilling the following criteria : (i) Said motor vehicles imported by an importer / individual based on the Letter(s) of Credit established on his/her name for personal usage or (ii) Said motor vehicles imported by any authorized agent / motor vehicles importer on the request of identified customer(s), who have paid required money to the said authorized agent / importer through any official channel(s) (financial institutions approved by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka) for importation of such vehicle(s) for personal usage. 2. Any importer or individual, fulfilling criteria listed above, shall submit his / her application as specified in the Schedule II of this <i>Gazette</i> Notification, to the Director General, Department of Fiscal Policy of the General Treasury along with all official / duly certified copies of evidence for authorizing clearance of such motor vehicle(s) from the Sri Lanka Customs on payment of Excise duty specified in Column II of Schedule I within four (04) months period from the date of publication of this <i>Gazette</i> Notification. 3. All motor vehicles, cleared from the Sri Lanka Customs under the proposed concession shall be registered in the name of the individuals referred in I above within 30 days from the date of release of such motor vehicles from the Sri Lanka Customs. Any motor vehicle, not be registered within 30 days from the date of release of Sri Lanka Customs, shall be liable for payment of applicable excise duty at the time of release of such motor vehicle from the Sri Lanka Customs	The rate of Excise duty applicable at the time of establishment of their respective Letters of Credit
