**WESTERN PROVINCE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL**

Notification made under Section 2(2) of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance No. 12 of 1946

By virtue of the powers vested in me under section 2(2) of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, read with Section 2 of the Provincial Councils (Consequential Provisions) Act, No. 12 of 1989, I Isura Dewapriya, the Chief Minister of Western Province and Minister of Finance and Planning, Engineering Services, Law and Order, Local Government and Provincial Administration, Economic Promotion, Electricity and Power, Environment Affairs, Water Supply and Drainage and Tourism Affairs of Western Province do by this order declare that I have approved to impose and charge, a 20% Entertainment Tax on entrance fee for entertainment activities stated in the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946 amended by Entertainment Tax (Amendment) Act, No. 37 of 1984, however only 7.5% to be charged for the entrance fee for films screened in Cinema halls within the limits of the Urban Council, the proposition No. 2583 of which has been made by the secretary of Urban Council Kalutara on 02<sup>nd</sup> November 2017 as per provisions stated in section 2 (1) of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance No. 12 of 1946 to be read with Section 184 (A) of Urban Council Ordinance.
