TRUSTS ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 87)

Order under Section 114

WHEREAS the Trustees of the "Sree Narayana Dharma Sangam Colombo Trust" namely -

have applied to the Minister of Justice, Human Rights and Legal Reforms for their incorporation under Section 114 of the Trusts Ordinance (Chapter 87);

Now therefore, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the aforesaid Ordinance, I, Nimal Siripala de Silva, Minister of Justice, Human Rights and Legal Reforms do by this Order authorize the incorporation of the said Trustees and direct and declare that-



- (a) the Trustees of the said Trust named above and their successors for the time being duly appointed under the Declaration of Trust bearing No. 169 of July 27, 2019 and August 5, 2019 attested by Saravanan Neelakandan, Notary Public of Colombo, shall be a body corporate with perpectual succession and a common seal under the name and style of the "Sree Narayana Dharma Sangam Colombo Trust";
- (b) the said Trustees may, under the said name and style, purchase, receive, hold, take on loan or otherwise acquire, sell, exchange, mortgage, pledge, lease or otherwise dispose of any property movable or immovable, on behalf of the said Trust; and
- (c) the said Trustees shall, by the said name and style, be able and competent in law to sue and to be sued, to answer and to be answered, to defend and be defended, in any court in Sri Lanka or elsewhere in all cases and actions arising in relation to the said Trust.

This Order may be revoked, or from time to time be varied or amended in such manner as appear to me to be necessary.
