GRANTING PERMISSION BY VIRTUE OF POWERS VESTED IN ME UNDER SECTION 27(A) OF PROVINCIAL COUNCIL ACT, No. 42 OF 1987 AS THE TERM OF THE SIXTH SABARAGAMUWA PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF THE DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA ENDED ON 26<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2017

1. This permission may be cited as “Permission to disburse under the third supplementary Financial Statement - 2022 of the Sabaragamuwa Provincial Council” and come in to operation from 12.10.2022.
2. The expenditure of the Sabaragamuwa Provincial Council which is estimated Rupees Thirty Nine Billion Six Hundred and Eight Million Three Hundred and Sixty Five Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Two and Cents Seventy Four only (39,608,365,772.74) for the service of the period beginning on 1st of January, 2022 and ending 31st of December 2022, which is specified as “Financial Year 2022” in the Annual Financial Statement and Revenue - Expenditure Estimates prepared for the year 2022, that was approved on 29.11.2021 and amended by the first supplementary budget 2022 and second supplementary budget, is hereby amended as, Rupees Forty Two Billion Four Hundred and Twenty One Million Forty Five Thousand Two Hundred and Forty and Cents Seventy Four only (Rs. 42,421,045,240.74) and grant permission to the Chief Secretary of this Province and other Accounting Officers to disburse the same from the Sabaragamuwa Provincial Council Fund.
3. Accordingly the first Schedule of the Annual Financial Statement and revenue - Expenditure Estimates - 2022, is amended as the first schedule hereof and grant permission to disburse the same.



4. This permission will be valid till 31st of December, 2022 or upto the date that expires three months (03) from the date of summoning the Seventh (07th) Sabaragamuwa Provincial Council or from the date re-start the functions of the Sabaragamuwa Provincial Council which occurs first.
