7.3.2.1. Educational and Professional Qualifications:

Should be an officer in Special Grade of the Sri Lanka Technological Service or a Livestock Development Officer or a Livestock Development Instructor or a Research Assistant presently serving in the Department of Animal Production and Health or a Livestock Development Instructor serving in the Provincial Public Service who has completed a satisfactory and active service period of 04 (four) years in Class I with a two-year diploma in Animal Husbandry awarded by the Sri Lanka School of Animal Husbandry or a two-year diploma in Agriculture awarded by the Sri Lanka School of Agriculture.

OR

Should be a Livestock Development Officer or a Livestock Development Instructor or a Research Assistant presently serving in the Department of Animal Production and Health or a Livestock Development Instructor serving in the Provincial Public Service who has completed a satisfactory and active service period of 5 (five) years in the relevant post with a four-year degree in Animal Science or Agriculture awarded by a university recognized by the University Grants Commission.
