- "4. Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon shall, when admitting students by lateral entry from the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) for the degree programme relating to the degree specified in Schedule II hereto in respect of -
 - (a) the Level 1 and Level 2 of the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC), adhere to the minimum entry qualification of, three (3) simple passes ('S') in biological science or physical science subject



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stream including chemistry as a subject, in one and the same sitting at the GCE (Advanced Level) Examination or equivalent with the pass of the aptitude test conducted by the educational arm (CCS) of the Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon;

- (b) The Level 2 of the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science, adhere to the minimum entry qualification of the successful completion of Level 1 of the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) in one sitting. Including -
 - (i) credit ('C') pass for 12 credits of compulsory chemistry course units (theory and practical) offered at Level 1 in the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 out of 4.0 ; and
 - (ii) minimum GPA of 2.0 out of 4.0 for all the enhancement course units offered at Level 1 in the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC);
- (c) The Level 3 of the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science, adhere to the minimum entry qualification of the successful completion of Level 2 of the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) in one sitting, including -
 - (i) credit ('C') pass for 24 credits of compulsory chemistry course units (theory and practical) offered at Level 1 and Level 2 in the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 out of 4.0; and
 - (ii) minimum GPA of 2.0 out of 4.0 for all the enhancement course units offered at Level 1 and Level 2 in the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC);
- (d) The Level 4 of the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science, adhere to the minimum entry qualification of the successful completion of Level 3 or Level 4 of the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) in one sitting, including -
 - (i) completion of minimum of 120 credits out of which minimum of 72 credits in Chemistry; and
 - (ii) completion of minimum of 42 credits of course units in Chemistry and 6 credits in Applied Management (APM) in Level 3 and Level 4.
- 5. All the students who laterally enrolled to the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science degree from the Level 1 or Level 2 of the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) shall complete 24 credits requirement of Applied Management Course (APM) at the end of the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science degree programme, to be eligible to be awarded the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science degree.
- 6. Institute of Chemistry, Ceylon is not allowed to offer the lateral entry from the Level 3 of the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) to the Level 4 of the Bachelor of Science Honours in Chemical Science, for any student who has registered for the Graduateship programme in Chemistry (GIC) in year 2020 and thereafter".
