Rules

1. These Rules may be cited as the Colombo Port City (Duty-Free Operations) Rules, No. 1 of 2023.
2. An authorised person engaged in duty-free operations -



- (a) shall not sell any goods other than the permitted goods specified in *Column I* of Schedule I to these rules in permitted quantities specified in the corresponding entry in *Column II* of that Schedule; and
- (b) shall sell any permitted goods referred to in subrule (a) as per the details of the allowances specified in *Column I* of Schedule II to these rules, within the permitted allowances and conditions specified in the corresponding entry in *Column II, Column III, Column IV, Column V, Column VI and Column VII* of that Schedule, to the permitted customers specified under the heading of each such column.

3. The authorised person referred to in rule 2 shall implement necessary procedures to verify and satisfy himself with the eligibility of the permitted customers to purchase permitted goods in permitted quantities within the permitted allowances and conditions as specified in the respective Schedules ;

4. The authorised person shall accept payments for any transaction in relation to duty-free operations in designated foreign currencies.

5. In these rules-

“duty-free operations” means the duty-free mall with multiple duty-free retail operators in the Area of Authority of the Colombo Port City;

“Sri Lankan Passport Holder” means a person holding a valid passport issued by the Department of Immigration and Emigration in Sri Lanka; and

“Tourist” means a foreign passport holder with a valid visa.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. The allowance stipulated (value in USD & units) is applicable for usage by the permitted customer at the Colombo Port City Duty-Free.
2. The Duty-Free allowance stipulated is applicable for the Colombo Port City Duty-Free only, and it is independent of that of any other Duty-Free allowances in existence in Sri Lanka.
3. All permitted customers specified in the heading to each column, will bear the responsibility for their respective purchases of Duty-Free products and the quantities, based on transit and final destination compliance applicability.
4. All applicable local taxes and restrictions of the carriage during transit and at the final destination will be the permitted customers' responsibility.
5. Duty-Free goods cannot be re-sold or exchanged by the permitted customer in Sri Lanka. Its sole purpose is for self-consumption and use among the family members.
6. The permitted customers shall be 16 years of age or above.

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
