Regulations

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Partition (Rates payable for surveying) Regulations.
- 2. The rates set out in Schedule I hereto, shall be the rates applicable in estimating the costs of the preliminary survey in a partition action in terms of the Partition Law, No. 21 of 1977.



- 3. The rates set out in Schedule II hereto shall be the rates applicable in determining the costs of survey for the final partition in terms of the Partition Law, No. 21 of 1977.
- 4. The Partition (Rates payable for surveying) Regulations, No. of 2014 published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1871/42 July 18, 2014 are hereby rescined.
