Regulations

1. These regulations may be cited as the Partition (Rates payable for surveying) Regulations.
2. The rates set out in Schedule I hereto, shall be the rates applicable in estimating the costs of the preliminary survey in a partition action in terms of the Partition Law, No. 21 of 1977.
