- (i) Payments not being made for unavailed leave from 2015 to 2022
- (ii) Not being given the opportunity to report to work at Ambalanthota Depot from 18.12.2020 to 31.12.2020 when he had been transferred from the Kataragama Depot to Ambalantota Depot through disciplinary order No. ශ්‍රී ලංගම/සමාසක/විනය/රුහුණපුරා/159/2020 dated 23.11.2020 and there by deprival of salary from 18.12.2020 to 31.12.2020
- (iii) Non-availing of the monthly availed 02 days duty-leave which is given for trade union activities, for the month of December 2020
- (iv) 07.02.2021 and 21.02.2021 been considered as days on which he had not reported to work.
