Regulations

The Fertilizer (Import, Manufacture and Formulation) Regulations, No. 1 of 2010, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1,683/5 of December 06, 2010 is hereby amended as follows :-

1. by the repeal of regulation 3 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following regulation :-

"3. The fee payable under Section 6 of the Act, in respect of the application for a licence shall be as follows :-

(a)	a licence to import fertilizer	-	Rs.	150,000.00
(b)	a licence to manufacture inorganic fertilizer	-	Rs.	150,000.00
(c)	a licence to manufacture organic or eco-friendly fertilizer	-	Rs.	20,000.00
(d)	a licence to formulate fertilizer	-	Rs.	150,000.00

Provided that, a person who manufactures organic or eco-friendly fertilizer for his own consumption shall not be required to obtain a licence under the provisions of Section 6 of the Act." and

2. by the repeal of regulation 4 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following regulation :-

"4. The fee payable under Section 8 of the Act, in respect of the application for the renewal of a licence shall be as follows :-

(a)	a licence to import fertilizer	-	Rs.	100,000.00
(b)	a licence to manufacture inorganic fertilizer	-	Rs.	100,000.00
(c)	a licence to manufacture organic or eco-friendly fertilizer	-	Rs.	15,000.00
(d)	a licence to formulate fertilizer	-	Rs.	100,000.00
