IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (CONTROL) ACT, No. 1 OF 1969

IN terms of the powers vested in me by Section 20 read together with Sub-section 4(1) and Section 14 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, No. 1 of 1969 as amended by Act, No. 48 of 1985 and Act, No. 28 of 1987, I, Anura Kumara Dissanayake, the Minister of Finance, Planning and Economic Development, Promulgate following Regulations.

Regulations

1. These Regulations may be cited as the “**Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 01 of 2026**”.
2. The Special Import License Regulations No.01 of 2023, Published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2312/77 dated January 01, 2023, as amended subsequently, is hereby further amended.

3. Notwithstanding the Regulation No. 03 of Special Import License Regulations No. 01 of 2023, published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2312/77 dated January 01,2023, importation of retreaded aircraft tyres that confirm to the requirements specified by internationally accredited aviation authorities and are classified under **HS Code 4012.13** listed out in the Schedule IV of said Regulations, under a duly executed Supply Agreement between the said Air Carrier and the Certified International Provider, is hereby allowed by Air Carriers of Sri Lanka providing international air services Subject to the recommendation of Secretary to the Ministry of Ports and Civil Aviation.
4. Goods imported under the Regulations No. 3 above shall be used exclusively within the Operational Boundaries of Bandaranaike International Airport and shall not be released to the local market or disposed within the country.
5. To achieve the objectives of these Regulations, the controller General of Imports and Exports shall issue “Operational Instructions” to the Director General of Customs, licensed banks or any other relevant authorities.
6. These regulations will only be enforced until 31.03.2028.
