THE AYURVEDA ACT, No. 31 OF 1961

RULES made by the Ayurvedic Medical Council under Paragraph (f) of Section 18 of the Ayurveda Act, No.31 of 1961 read with Section 19 and 50 of that Act.

Rule

1. The Registered Ayurvedic Medical Practitioners (Professional Conduct) Rules No. 01 of 2014 published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1884/36 of October 15, 2014 is hereby amended as follows :-

(1) by the insertion, immediately after rule 2 thereof, of the following new rule which shall have effect as rule 2A:-

“2A. The official seal of an Ayurveda medical practitioner shall only contain-

- (a) the registration number of such practitioner;
- (b) the title of such practitioner; and
- (c) the professional qualifications approved by the Ayurveda Medical Council.”;and



(2) by the repeal of rule 10 thereof, and the substitution therefor of the following :-

“10. Every Ayurvedic Medical Practitioner shall renew-

(a) his registration as an Ayurveda Medical Practitioner; and

(b) the identity card issued to him in proof of such registration,

once in every five years.”.

2. Notwithstanding the coming into force of these rules, every registration of an Ayurveda Medical Practitioner obtained in terms of the Ayurveda Act, No. 31 of 1961 or renewed in terms of the Registered Ayurvedic Medical Practitioners (Professional Conduct) Rules No. 01 of 2014 published in the *Gazette* Extraordinary No. 1884/36 of October 15, 2014, which remain valid at the time of publication of these rules shall continue to be in force during their respective periods of validity.
