AS per the powers vested by Chapter 252, Municipal Councils Ordinance of Sri Lanka amended by Municipal Councils Acts (Amendment) No. 42 of 1972, No. 20 of 1985 No. 39 of 1986, under sections 247 (a), 247(b) and 247(c) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, charging of permit fees and taxes by the Municipal Council of Sri Jayewardenapura Kotte, for the year 2013.

As per the Council determination No. 06-01 of the Municipal Council taken on 25th October, 2012, until such time that the revisions introduced in 2013 and thereafter are published by *Gazette* Notification as relevant for the information of the Public, it is

announced through this that the trade licence fees relevant to industries and/or trading undertaking will be charged by the Sri Jayewardenapura Kotte Municipal Council in the following manner.

01. (1) For business undertakings coming under section 247(a) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, based on the annual value of the premises, payment as licence fees shall be made for the year 2013 as per schedule No.01.
- (2) for industries coming under Section 247(b) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance payment as taxes should be made for the year 2013 based on the annual value of the premises, as per schedule No.02.
- (3) Taxes for business undertaking coming under Section 247(c) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance should be

paid for the year 2013 based on the previous years' turnover as per schedule No. 03.

- (4) Under Section 247(a) of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, a hotel, restaurant or lodging house registered with the Tourist Board of Sri Lanka or approved or recognized by that Board should pay one percentum (1%) of its previous years' turnover as the licence fee for the year 2013. A hotel, restaurant or lodging house that has not been registered with the Tourist Board, should pay the licence fee on the annual value of such permits under Section 247 (a).

- (5) The relevant applications and/or documents and reports etc. related to obtaining licenses and payment of taxes stipulated in the following Schedules shall be submitted to the Municipal Commissioner before 01st January, 2013 and the said License fee and taxes should be paid within 30 days from the date of informing.

02. Charging of license fees and taxes for 2013 stipulated in the following schedules will be implemented on the following bases.

1. If a single person conducts a single business under one rate number in a building or buildings with one storey or several storeys, it will be considered as a single premise only for the purpose of calculating the annual license fee or tax and license fee or trade tax will be charged accordingly.
2. If a single person conduct various businesses under one rate number in building or buildings with one storey or several storeys, license fees for trade taxes will be charged separately, by apportioning the annual value or turnover of the trade as per the floor area used for each business or industry.
3. When the building where a single person conducts a single type of business is a building with several rate numbers, trade taxes or licences fee will be charged considering it as a business conducted under a single rate number.  
  
However, in case the maximum license fee or trade tax of such premise happens to be less than 5000 Rupees on such occasion the license fee or trade taxes will be decided based on the total annual value calculated by adding up the annual value of rate numbers of all those buildings.
4. when a single person is conducting various businesses under several rate numbers, separate licence fees or business taxes will be charged for each of these businesses or industries on such occasion, even though the said rate numbers are of adjoining premises.
5. If several persons conduct business under a single rate number, license fees or business taxes will be charged separately by apportioning the annual value of the said business premises as per the annual value of the premises used for each business.

Power to determine the license fees and the business taxes shall remain with the Municipal Council.

03. It is further announced hereby that these licence fees and taxes payable for the year 2013 have to be paid on or before 31st March, 2013.

03. Where a certain trade name or name of a production company of a certain merchandize or commodity is displayed on the name board carrying the name of a trade establishment, 50% of the relevant graded charge is payable for such board and the graded charge for additional boards.

06. Charges for advertisements and name boards displayed by the owners of businesses conducted in shopping complexes and market premises owned by the Municipal Council.

01. The name board with the name of the firm that is conducting business in that premises is exempted from charges, subject to a maximum size of 20 square feet.

02. Where a trade name or name of a production company of a certain merchandize or commodity is displayed on such name board which is subject to the maximum size of 20 square feet, an annual charge of Rs. 100.00 square feet is payable.

07. Charges for hoardings within the properties and buildings owned by the Council. The Council shall have the power to determine the consideration of granting approval and levying charges with relevance to the display of advertisements.

(b) Imposing and levying charges on advertisements will be based on the following.

(1) Where hoarding display on more than one side, 50% of the standard charge is payable for the additional side/sides.

- (2) Grading the places where hoardings are set up, according to the roads :

*Roads coming under super grade :*  
Sri Jayewardenapura Mawatha.

Stanley Thilakarathna Mawatha from Samudra Devi Vidyalaya Road up to the place where Pagoda Road begins.

High-level Road, from Council limits at Vijerama Junction up to the Council limits at Jambugasmulla Road.

Nawala Road, from Nugegoda up to Senanayake Mawatha, Nawala.

Old Kesbewa Road, from Nugegoda Roundabout up to the Railway Crossing.

*A Grade Roads :*

From Athulkotte to Jubilee Post  
From Jubilee Post up to Stanley Thilakarathne Mawatha where Pagoda Road begins.  
From Nawala road Municipal Council Limis up to Senanayake Mawatha,  
From Railway crossing on old Kesbewa Road up to Delkanda Junction.

From Rattanapitiya Road, from Delkanda junction limits upto Municipal Council limits from old Kottawa Orad, Jubilee Post Junction upto Embuldeniya limits and Udahamulla.  
From where old Kottawa Road begins upto Clombo Municipal Council limits.

Roads under the Provincial Council

*Roads coming under C grade :*  
Roads under the Municipal Council

*Roads coming under D grade :*

All private roads located within the administrative limits of the Councils and not coming under A, B and C grades above.

- (3) 7 days prior to publishing of all advertisements, approval of the Urban Commissioner should be obtained by submitting this relevant form together with a photocopy of the advertisement and a permit should be obtained by making the relevant payments.

- (4) It is hereby announced that the permit charges mentioned above have to be paid for the display of hoarding for 2013, pursuant to decision No. 06-01 of the Council taken on 25th October, 2012.
