NOTIFICATION MADE UNDER STATE LAND REGULATION No. 21 (2)

IT is hereby notified that for the Agricultural Purpose, Mrs. Ranathunga Appuhamilage Magilin Jayawardhana has requested on lease a State land containing in extent about 2.429 Hec. marked Lot No. 280 as depicted in the plan FVP 2848 and situated in the village of Amunakole which belongs to the Grama Niladhari Division of No. 355, Amunakole coming within the area of authority of the Polpithigama Divisional Secretariat in the District of Kurunegala.

02. Given below are the boundaries of the land requested :

- (d) The lessees must not use this land for any purposes other than for the Agricultural purpose;
- (e) The lease must also be subject to the other special conditions stipulated and imposed by the Divisional Secretary and by other Institutions;
- (f) Once the land is given on lease and in the event of failure on the part of the lessees to substantiate within the specified time frame the purpose for which the land was obtained, action will be taken to terminate the lease;
- (g) No sub leasing can be done until the expiry of a minimum period of 05 years from the date of 15.10.2015;
- (h) Payment of the lease must be regularly made and if defaulted in payment, the agreement will *ipso facto* lapse;

If acceptable reasons are not submitted to me in writing within six weeks of the date herein below to the effect that this land must not be given on lease, the land will be leased out as requested.
