All notices to be published in the weekly *Gazettes* shall close at 12.00 noon of each Friday, two weeks before the date of publication. All Government Departments, corporations, Boards, etc. are hereby advised that Notifications fixing closing dates and times of applications in respect of Post-Vacancies, Examinations, Tender Notices and dates and times of Auction Sales, etc. should be prepared by giving adequate time both from the date of despatch of notices to Govt. Press and from the date of publication, thereby enabling those interested in the contents of such notices to actively and positively participate please note that inquiries and complaints made in respect of corrections pertaining to notification will not be entertained after **three months** from the date of publication.

All notices to be published in the weekly *Gazettes* should reach Government Press two weeks before the date of publication *i.e.* Notices for publication in the weekly *Gazette* of 09th November 2018 should reach Government Press on or before 12.00 noon on 26th October 2018.

#### Electronic Transactions Act, No. 19 of 2006 - Section 9

## Miscellaneous Notices

### AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE KELANIYA BUDDHIST WOMEN'S CHARITABLE SOCIETY ACT

I, Ven. Athuraliye Rathana Thero do hereby give notice, under Standing Order No. 53 (1) of the Standing Orders of the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, that I propose to introduce in Parliament a Bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Kelaniya Buddhist Women's Charitable Society.

The aim of the Bill is to incorporate the said Society which has the following general objects :-

- (1) to maintain a Senehasa Child Development Center in the name of "Senehasa Dari Sevana Children's Home" at No. 307/16, Jayamawatha, Webada, Kirillawala by

- promoting the education, Virtues and Cultural activities of the destitute, abandoned daughters of low income Buddhist families giving them the education from primary level up to the university standard ;
- (2) to select the students of low income families in Gampaha District and to guide them to obtain health facilities and professional talents necessary for promoting their education and talents and granting them with financial scholarships ;
- (3) to act in order to convince the Buddhism for every one and to take necessary actions to propagate Buddhism all over the world,
