APPLICATIONS are invited for the Post of Maintenance Technician in the Category of Primary Semi-skilled Service in the Department of Provincial Industries under the Ministry of Roads, Transport, Cooperative Development and Trade, Housing Construction, Infrastructural Facilities of Estates and Industrial and Rural Development.

Number of Vacancies : 01

1. *General Conditions :*

- 1:1 This post is permanent and pensionable. The selected candidate should obey by the rules and regulations pertaining to pensions taken by the government from time to time, and should contribute to the 'Widows and Orphans' Pension Scheme.
- 1.2 Selected candidates will be appointed to this service on a probationary period of three years from the date of appointment.
- 1.3 Selected candidate should work according to the orders or regulations of the Ministry of Department or other regulations imposed by the Public Service Commission of the Western Province from time to time, orders or regulations imposed by the Governor of the Western Province from time to time, orders or regulations of the Western Province, procedural rules code of the Public Service procedures, Establishment Code and Financial Regulations of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.
- 1.4 According to the G.P.C. No. 01/2014, should agree to the Language Policy of the Government.

2. *Salary Scale and age Limit :*

- 2.1 Annual Total Salary - (According to the G.P.C. No. 03/2016 PL-2-2016)
- 2.2 Salary Scale - Rs. 25,250- 10x270-10x300 - 10x330 - 12x350 - Rs. 38,450
- 2.3 Age should not be below 18 years and not more than 45 years on 18.05.2019

3. *Qualification of Recruitment :*

3.1 *Educational Qualifications :*

Should have passed in Six subjects with 02 credit passes at the G.C.E. (O/L) within not more than 02 sittings (05 subjects should be in one sitting)

3.2 *Professional Qualifications :*

Obtain Level II of NVQ in Electricity. (Should be approved by a recognized certificate)

3.3 *Experience :* 01 year experience in Machinery and Electrical Maintenance from a recognised institution of related to the field and a fair knowledge of Electrical Maintenance, soldering, welding, air-conditioning, Machinery Maintenance, and Plumbing are considered as an additional qualification.

4. *Other Qualifications :*

4.1 Candidates should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.

4.2 Applicants should prove that they are the permanent residents of Western Province at least 03 years completed on the closing date of applications.

4.3 Applicant must have an excellent character and physically fit to work

4.4 A physical fitness should have to work in any place in the Western Province

And the receipt obtained for this examination cannot be used for another Examination.

7. *Special matter :*

It will be the final decision of Secretary of the Ministry, regarding the facts within the instruction of calling applications or any other reason not in the same instructions of calling applications.
