10. **Syllabus:** competitive examination consists of two question papers.

10.1. Intelligent and aptitude test– (Time - 01 hour, Maximum marks – 100) (pass marks – 40%)

This question paper consists of multiple choice and structured questions to gauge applicants' language proficiency, arithmetical skills, logical strength and general intelligence.

10.2. General Knowledge and Subject Based Knowledge

(Time - 02 hours, Maximum marks – 100) (Pass marks – 40%)

This question paper consists of multiple choices, structured and essay type questions to gauge applicants' subject knowledge on Community Development and knowledge on current social and political information.

11. Instruction on Application :

A specimen of the application for this examination is appended to the end of this notification. The application should accordingly be prepared only on A4 size paper using both sides of the paper, so as paragraphs 01 to 05 in the first page, and the rest in other pages of the application.
