It is hereby announced that the above examination will be conducted by the North Western Provincial Council Public Service Commission in May, 2026 at an examination centre established in Kurunegala. North Western Provincial Public Service Commission reserves the right of postponing or cancelling the examination.

01. Educational and Professional Qualifications:

For the post mentioned above,

(a) Educational Qualifications:

Should have passed three (03) subjects under the Mathematics Stream, including Physics and Mathematics, at the General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) Examination in the same sitting

Or

Should have passed three (03) subjects under Technology Stream, including Engineering Technology, Science for Technology, at the General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) Examination in the same sitting

Should have passed six (06) subjects in the same sitting, with credit passes for Sinhala or Tamil or English Language, Science, Mathematics, and one (01) other subject, at the General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination

02. Other Qualifications :-

- 2.3 Should be a permanent resident of the North Western Province during the preceding three years of the closing date of application. (Residency should be proved by a Certificate of Residence (DS 04) issued by the Grama Niladhari at the time of Interview. The applicants whose Permanent residence in North Western Province is less than 03 years as at the closing date for applications must also produce DS 04 Grama Niladhari certificate to prove their period of residence.
- 2.4 In cases where the applicants permanent residence in North Western Province is less than 03 years as at the closing date for applications, if the applicant's spouse has been a permanent resident of North Western Province for at least 03 years such applicants will also be considered in accordance with Section 2.3 above. - 2.5 If enrolled to the post concerned, it is compulsory to serve at least 10 years in North Western Province.

04. Conditions of Service:-

- 4.1 This post is permanent. The pension scheme applicable to this post will be subject to a policy decision taken by the Government in the future.
- 4.2 The appointees to this post will be subject to a probation period of (three) 03 years and will be confirmed at the end of the probation period, if his/her work and conduct is satisfactory, and if the appointee has passed the First Efficiency Bar, and if he/she has satisfied the other requirements needed to be confirmed in the service.

05. Method of Recruitment:-

- 5.1 Recruitment will be made on the results of a written competitive examination and a general interview. A merit list will be prepared on the total marks obtained for both subjects out of the applicants who have obtained 40% or more for each examination paper prescribed for the examination syllabus. Number of applicants equal to the expected number to be recruited will be summoned to the interview and eligible persons will be selected. Only if the number of applicants with relevant educational and professional qualifications is less than the number of vacancies they will be recruited from the interview without written examination.
- 5.2 The marks will not be given at the interview. Only educational, professional, and other required basic qualifications and physical fitness will be checked.
- 5.3 After successfully completing the one-year training period, they will be appointed to Grade III after passing the examination conducted by the North Western Provincial Council Public Service Commission.

Note:- If there is any apprentice who could not pass the examination conducted after the above mentioned training period, opportunity will be given to extend their training period up to 06 months. If they fail the examination conducted at the end of extended training period, their appointment will be terminated.

06. Written Examination:-

01. Intelligence Quotient Test

This question Paper will be comprised of short questions and multiple choice questions to test the language skills, mathematical skills, and logical thinking of the candidates.

02. Subject Related Technical Test

A question paper to test the basic knowledge on architecture, drawing according to a scale, understanding ability of a plan or rough sketch, basic knowledge on structural designs, knowledge on surveying, basic knowledge on geometrical and mechanical drawing.

07. Examination Fees:-

A sum of Rupees One Thousand Two Hundred (Rs. 1,200/-) as the examination fee should be paid to any Divisional Secretariat in the North Western Province, to be credited to the Revenue Head 2003-02-13 of the North Western Provincial Council. The receipt No. ඩ.ප.ස. මු. 02, obtained from the Divisional Secretariat in the name of the applicant, should be affixed in the appropriate cage of the application. 02.01 Salary Scale:

03. Educational and Other Qualifications: -
